This medicine is available without prescription. However, you still need to take Rennie® Orange tablets carefully to get the best results from them. Keep this leaflet, you may need to read it again. If you have any unusual effects after taking Rennie® Orange, tell your

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doctor or pharmacist.

WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

1. WHAT IS RENNIE® ORANGE AND

Rennie® Orange is an antacid tablet which relieves stomach upset due to excess acid and heartburn (e.g. indigestion,

hyperacidity, flatulence, dyspepsia, biliousness and acid indigestion).

2. BEFORE YOU TAKE RENNIE® ORANGE Do not take Rennie® Orange:

- If you have severe kidney disease or suffer from kidney stones. · If you have high calcium levels in the
 - blood, kidnevs or urine.
- · If you have low phosphate levels in the blood.
- If you are allergic (hypersensitive) to any of the ingredients (listed in Section 6. Further information).

As with other antacid products, taking these tablets can mask the symptoms of other, more serious, underlying medical conditions. Do not exceed the stated dose. If symptoms persist after seven days consult your doctor. Patients aged 55 years or older with unexplained and persistent heartburn should contact their doctor before taking Rennie® Orange. Rennie® is designed to help relieve pain associated with excess stomach acid. Pain/discomfort associated with cardiac conditions may on occasion mimic indigestion; such pain will not respond to Rennie, therefore it is recommended that medical advice be sought if the pain does

- To maximise the benefit of all medicines being used, take Rennie® Orange 1 to 2 hours after taking any other medicines.
